## Fall 2007 highlights

### Enrollment --

- Total enrollment for Fall 2007 is 24,704 -- an increase of 5% over the previous fall semester
- Student Credit Hours are up 6.2% over the previous fall semester
- Total undergraduate headcount enrollment is up 995 students to 20,668 (a 5.1% increase)
- Total graduate headcount enrollment is up 167 students (5.0% increase)
- Enrollment for full-time students is up for both undergraduates and graduates

### Demographics --

- International enrollment is up 9.7% (846 compared to 771)
- Enrollment for both male and female students is up, 7.5% and 2.7%, respectively
- Minority student enrollment is up 2.1%

### New Freshmen --

- Freshmen applications up 2%
- New freshmen enrollees increased by 6%
- Since Fall 05, New Freshmen enrollees increased by 25%
- Direct Admits and Honors students are up by 8% and 2%, respectively
- New Freshmen ACT scores up slightly from 20.6 to 20.9

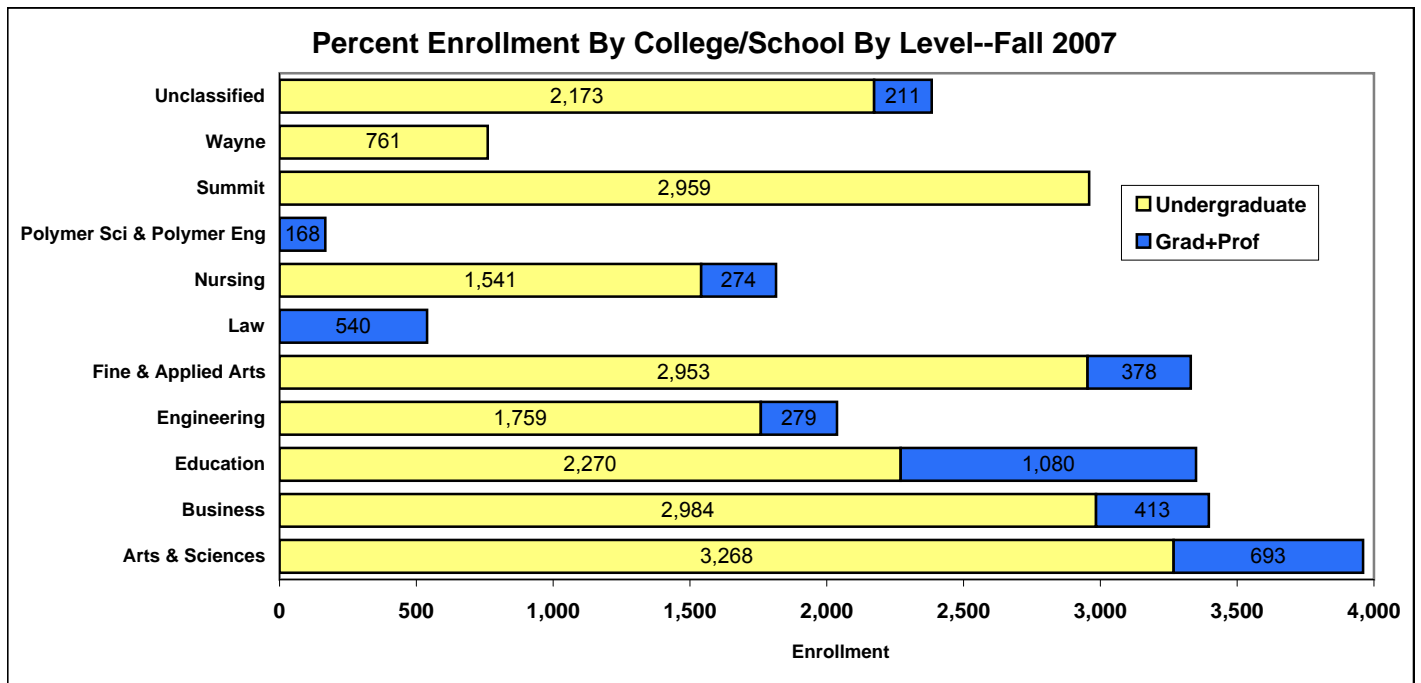

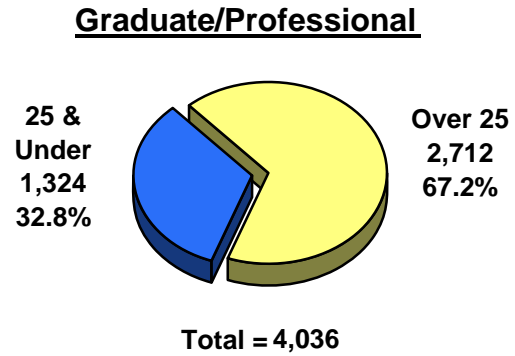
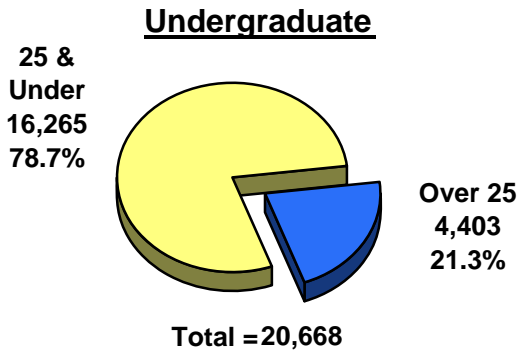

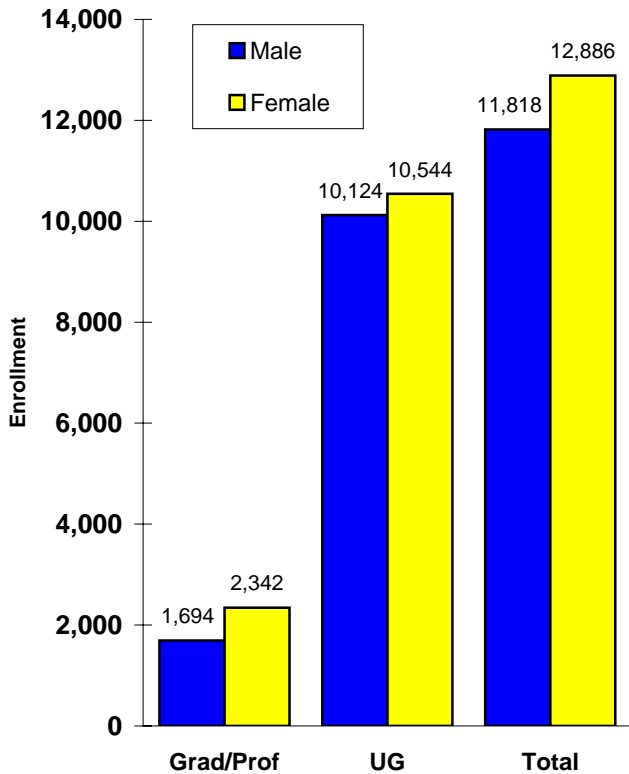
