Enrollment Summary
Fall Semester 2009**

Fall 2009 highlights

Enrollment --

- Total enrollment for Fall 2009 is 27,911 -- an increase of 7.6% over the previous fall semester
- Student Credit Hours are up 8.4% over the previous fall semester
- Total undergraduate headcount enrollment is up 1,642 students to 23,277 (a 7.6% increase)
- Total graduate headcount enrollment is up 293 students (7.7% increase)
- Enrollment for full-time students is up for both undergraduates and graduates

Demographics --

- International enrollment is up 8.7% (941 compared to 866)
- Enrollment for both male and female students is up, 8.9% and 6.4%, respectively
- Minority student enrollment is up 13.3%
- Undergraduate Adult enrollment is up 8.7% (5,012 compared to 5,447)
- Out-of-State undergraduate enrollment increased 11.1%

New Freshmen --

- New freshmen enrollees increased by 6.4%
- Since Fall 05, New Freshmen enrollees increased by 34%

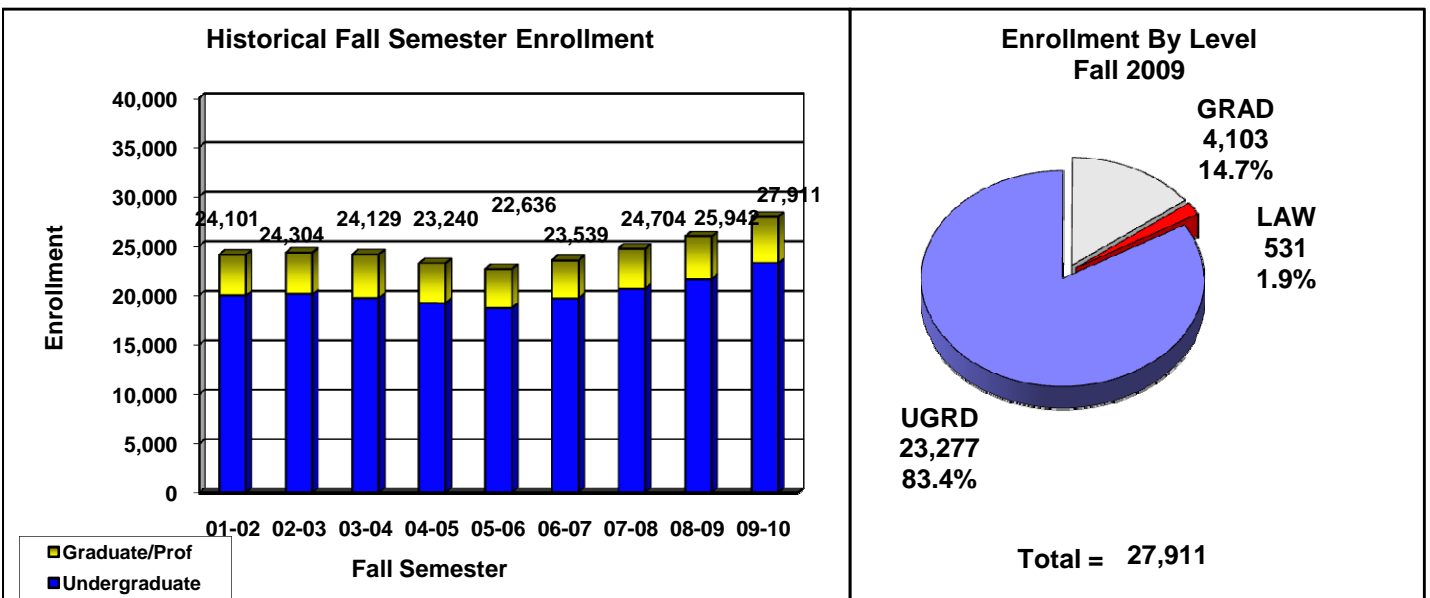

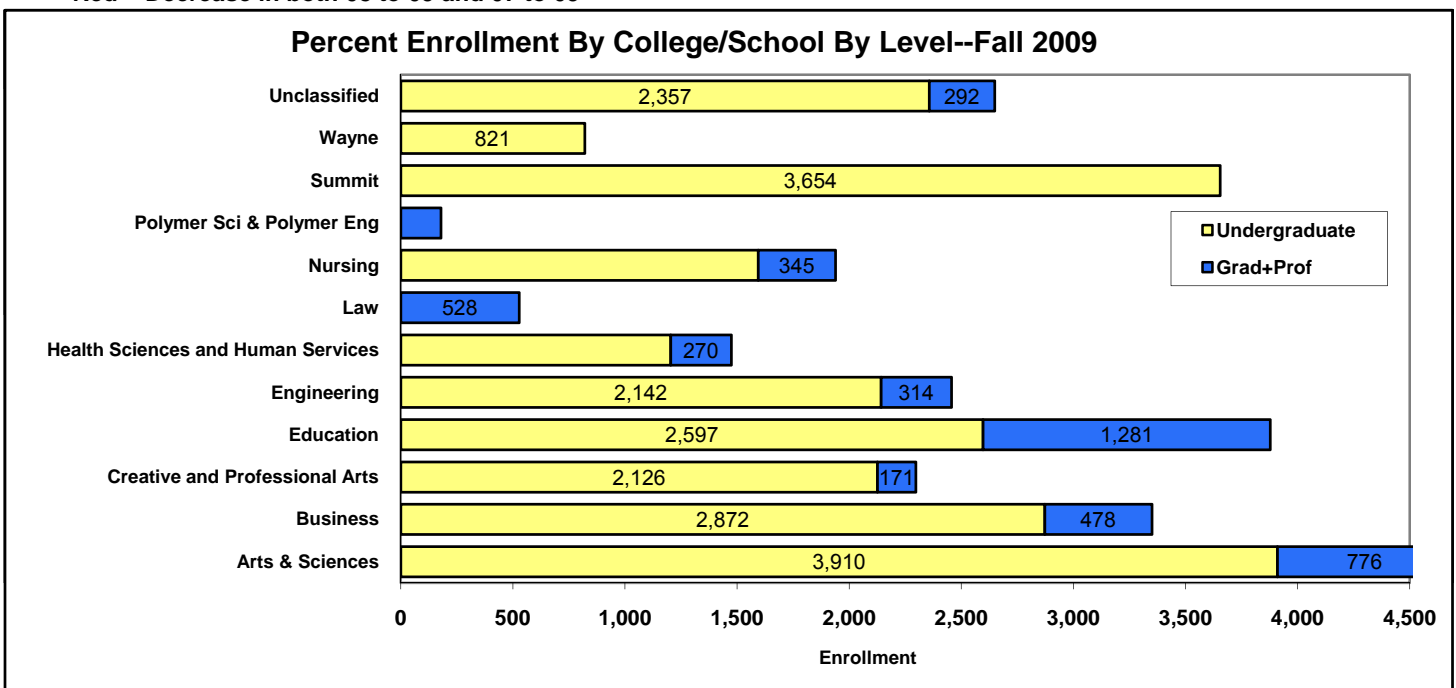

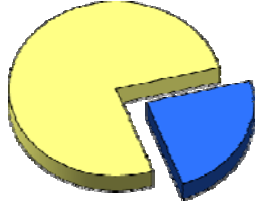

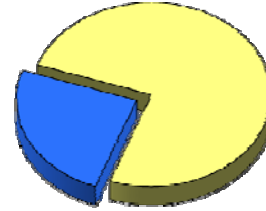

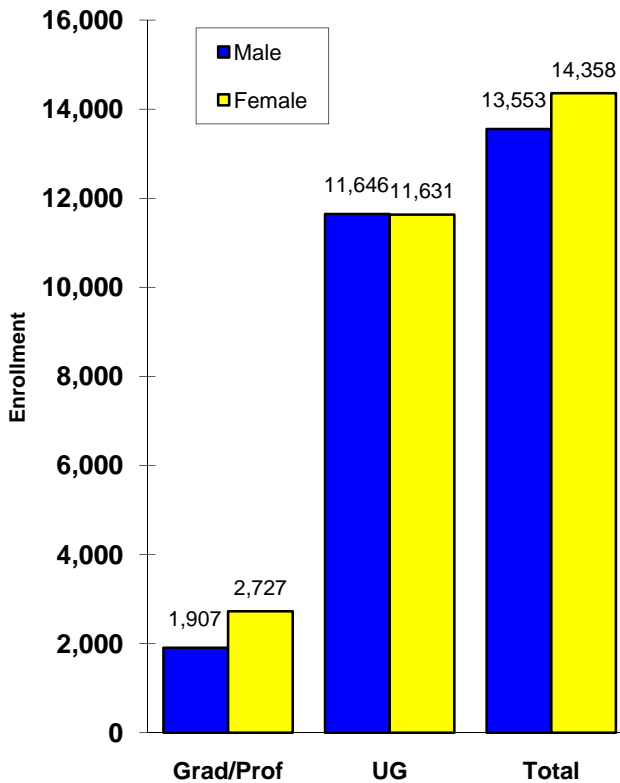
