Enrollment Summary
Fall Semester 2006**

Fall 2006 highlights

Enrollment --

- Total enrollment for Fall 2006 is 23,539 -- an increase of 4% over the previous fall semester
- Student Credit Hours are up 5.3% over the previous fall semester
- Total undergraduate headcount enrollment is up 946 students to 19,673 (a 5.1% increase)
- Total graduate headcount enrollment is down 48 students (1.4% decrease)
- Enrollment for full-time students is up for both undergraduates and graduates

Demographics --

- Out-of-state enrollment is up 38% (849 compared to 615)
- International enrollment is up 17.4% (771 compared to 657)
- Enrollment for both male and female students is up, 5.5% and 2.7%, respectively
- Minority student enrollment is up 2.7%

New Freshmen --

- Freshmen applications up 26%
- New freshmen enrollees increased by 16%
- Direct Admits and Honors students are up by 26% and 14%, respectively
- New Freshmen ACT scores up slightly from 20.4 to 20.6

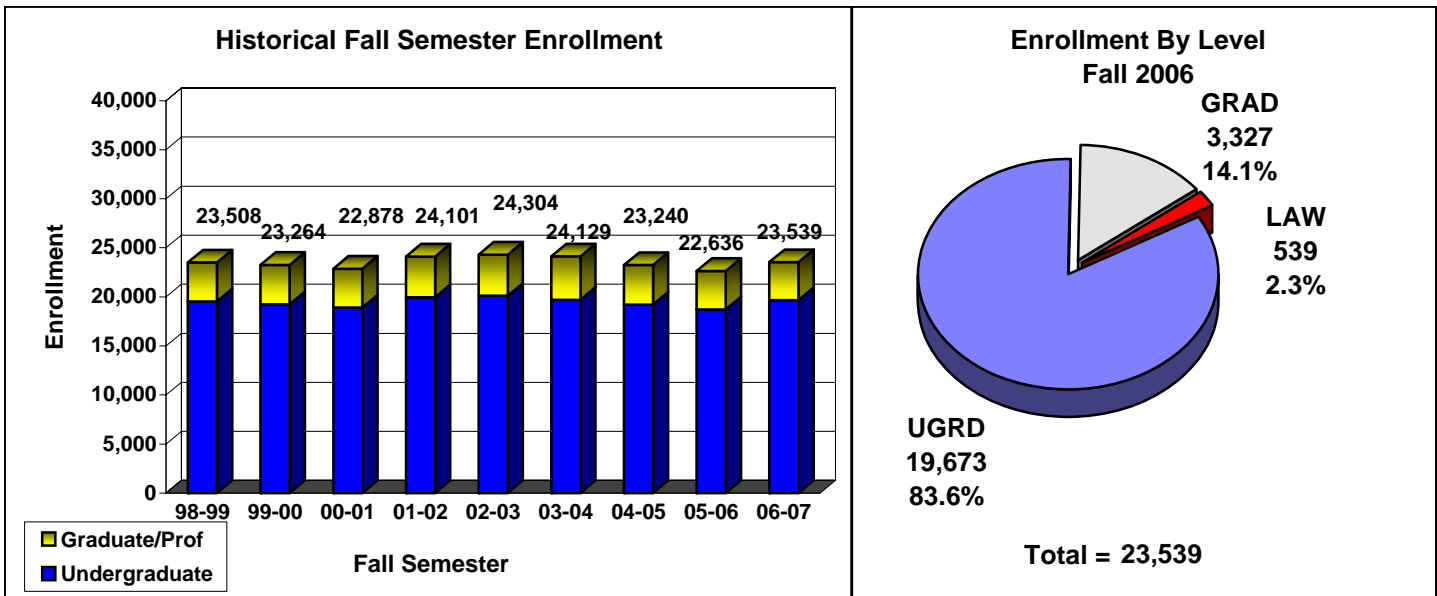

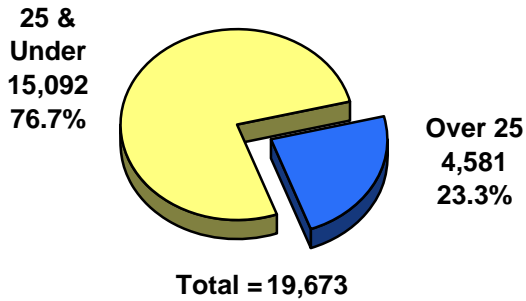

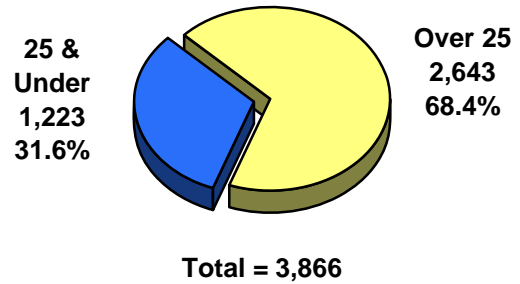

Undergraduate



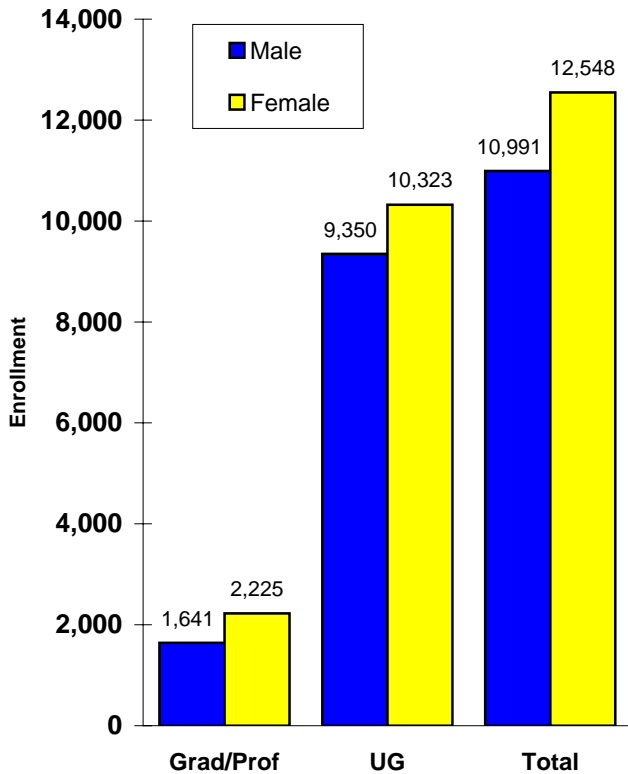
