Enrollment Summary
Spring Semester 2007**

Spring 2007 highlights

Enrollment --

- Total enrollment for Spring 2007 is 22,835 -- an increase of 5% over the previous spring semester
- Student Credit Hours are up 6.6% over the previous spring semester
- Total undergraduate headcount enrollment is up 897 students to 18,844 (a 5.0% increase)
- Total graduate headcount enrollment is up 175 students (5.3% increase)
- Enrollment for full-time students is up more than 5% for both undergraduates and graduates (6.9% and 9.3% respectively)
- Enrollment for part-time students is also up for both undergraduates and graduates (1.0% and 1.7% respectively)

Demographics --

- Out-of-state enrollment is up 4.7% (531 compared to 507)
- International enrollment is up 13.6% (791 compared to 696)
- Enrollment for both male and female students is up, 7.0% and 3.1%, respectively
- Minority student enrollment is up 1.1%

Retention --

- Fall to Spring retention for all students was 85.8% (up from 83.4%)
- New Fall 06 freshmen were also retained at a higher rate than the previous year (84.7% compared to 83.1%)

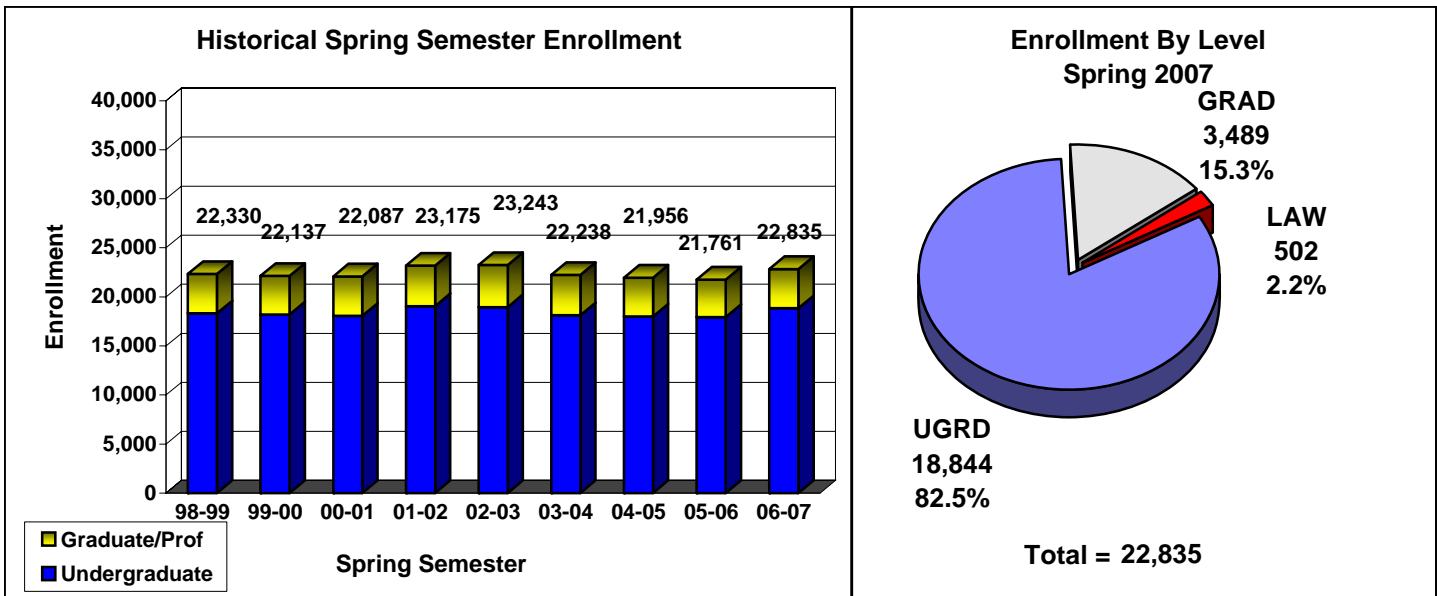

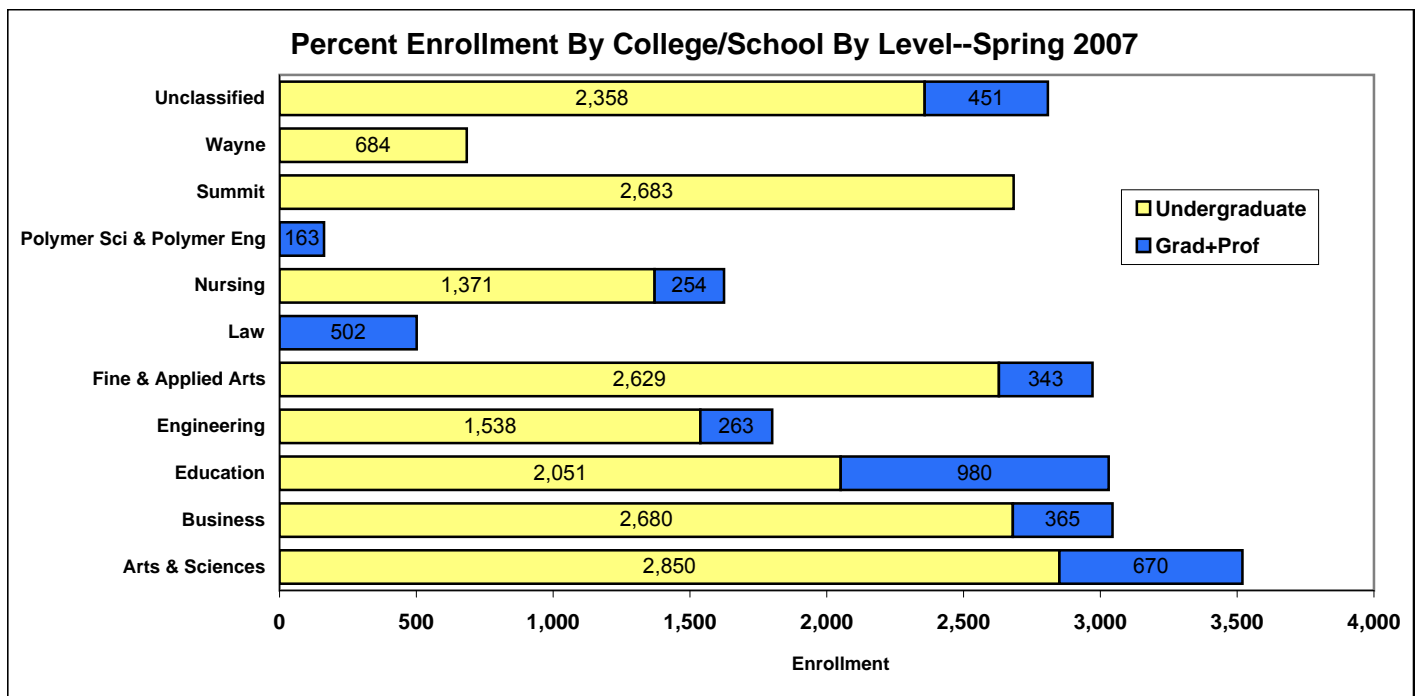

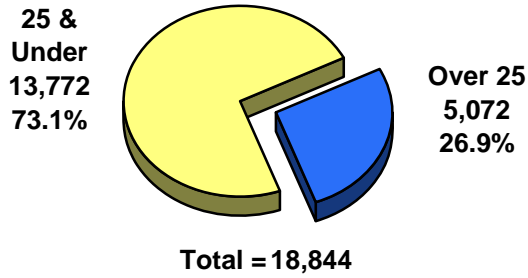

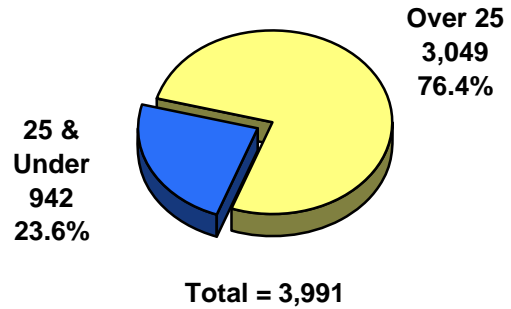


Age By Level--Spring 2007

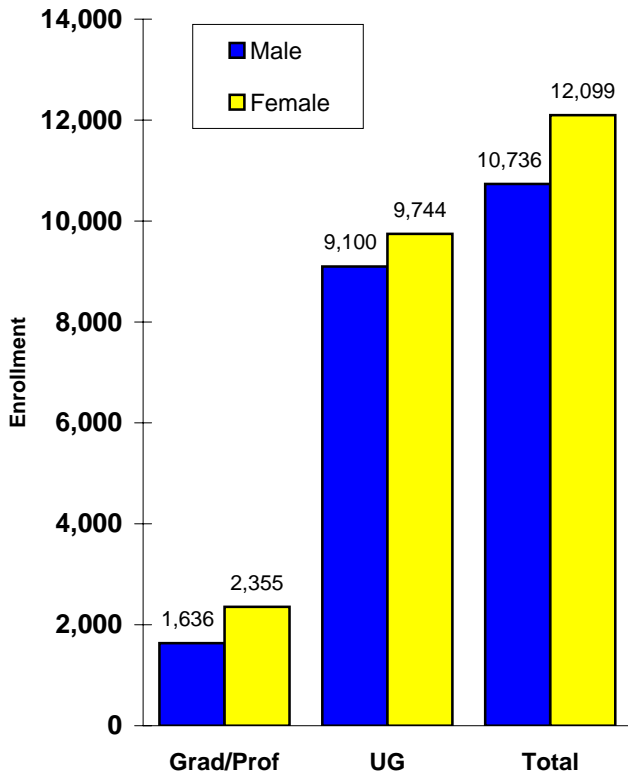
