## Spring 2008 highlights

### Enrollment --

- Total enrollment for Spring 2008 is 23,754 -- an increase of 4% over the previous spring semester
- Student Credit Hours are up 5.3% over the previous spring semester
- Total undergraduate headcount enrollment is up 775 students to 19,619 (a 4.1% increase)
- Total graduate headcount enrollment is up 139 students (4.0% increase)
- Enrollment for full-time students is up more than 5% for both undergraduates and graduates (7.3% and 3.1% respectively)
- Enrollment for part-time students is down for undergraduates (3.2% decrease) and up for graduates (4.9% increase)

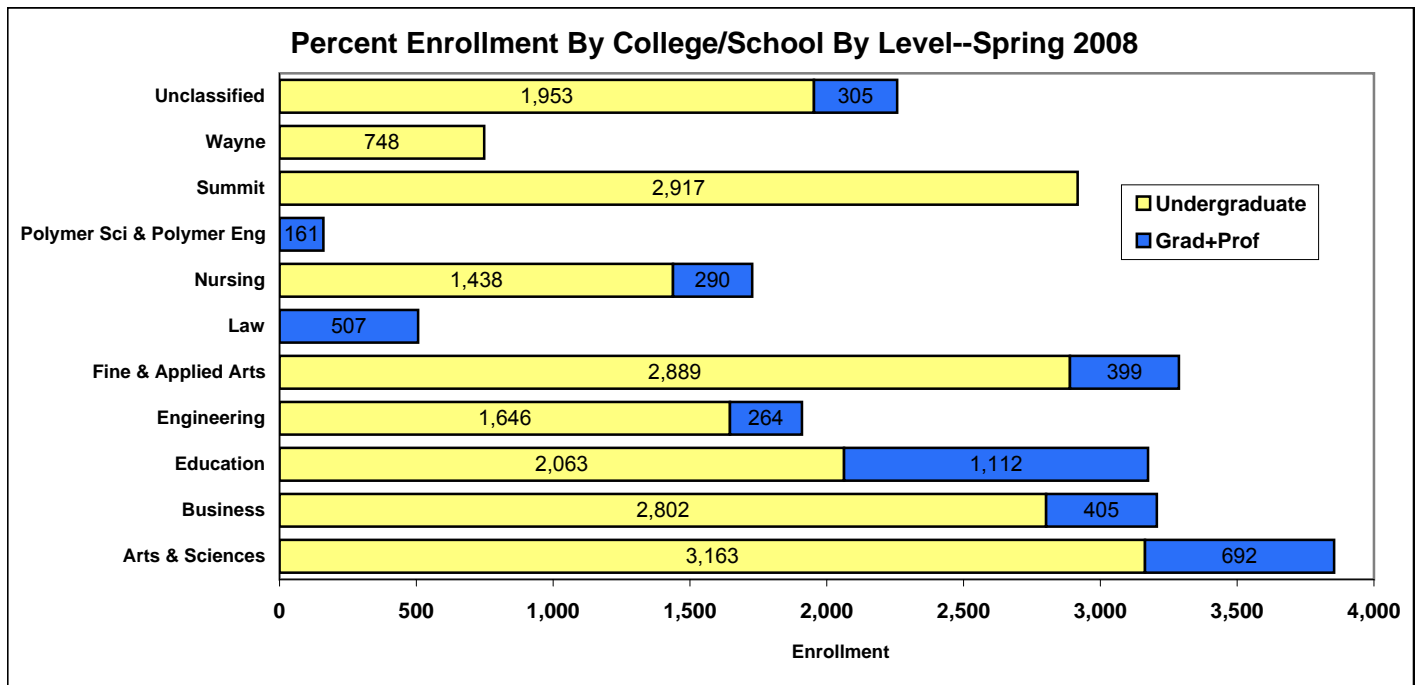

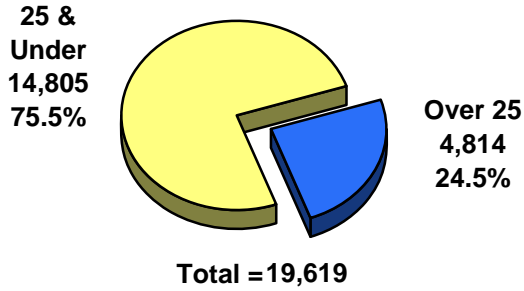

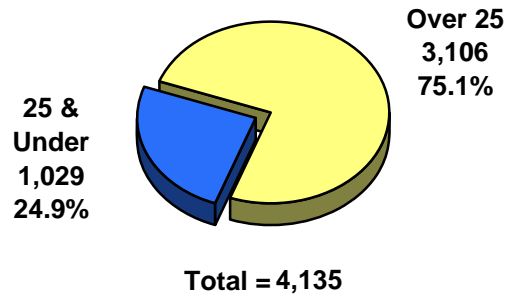


**Age By Level--Spring 2008**

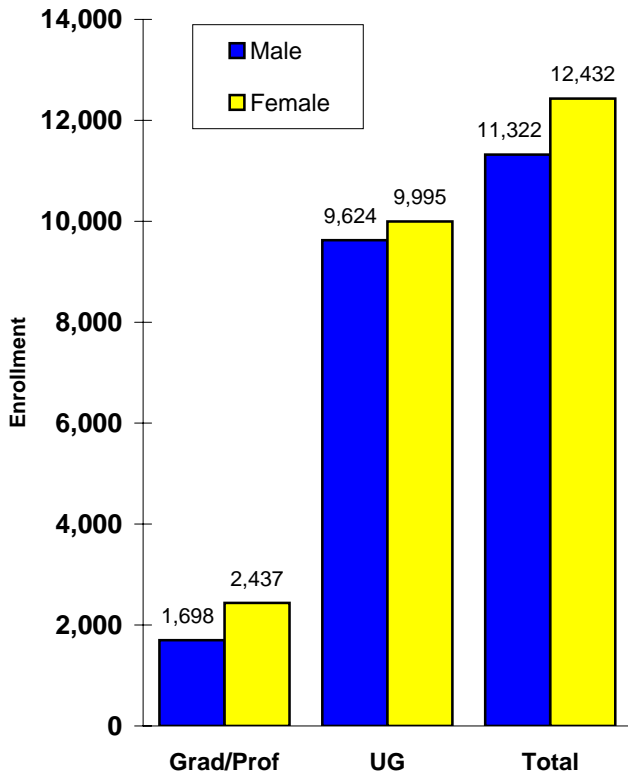
