Spring Semester 2009**

Spring 2009 highlights

Enrollment --

- Total enrollment for Spring 2009 is 25,103 -- an increase of 5.7% over the previous spring semester
- Student Credit Hours are up 5.8% over the previous spring semester
- Total undergraduate headcount enrollment is up 977 students to 20,596 (a 5% increase)
- Total graduate headcount enrollment is up 421 students (11.6% increase)
- Enrollment for full-time students is up more than 5% for both undergraduates and graduates (6.4% and 5.5% respectively)
- Enrollment for part-time students is also up for both undergraduates and graduates (1.4% and 17.3% respectively)

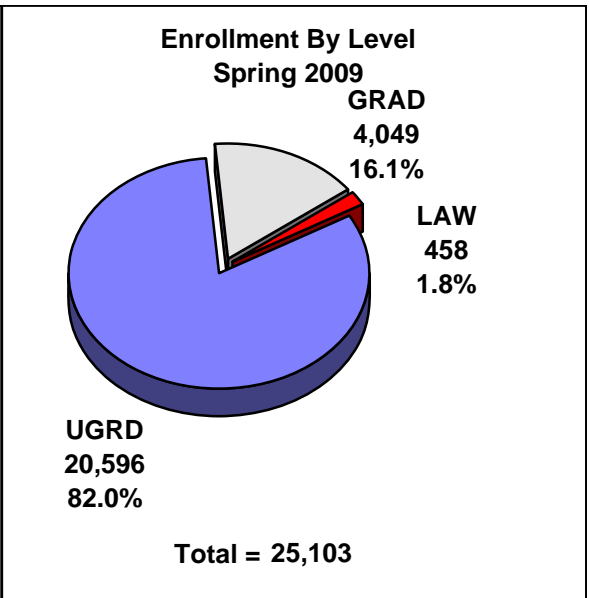

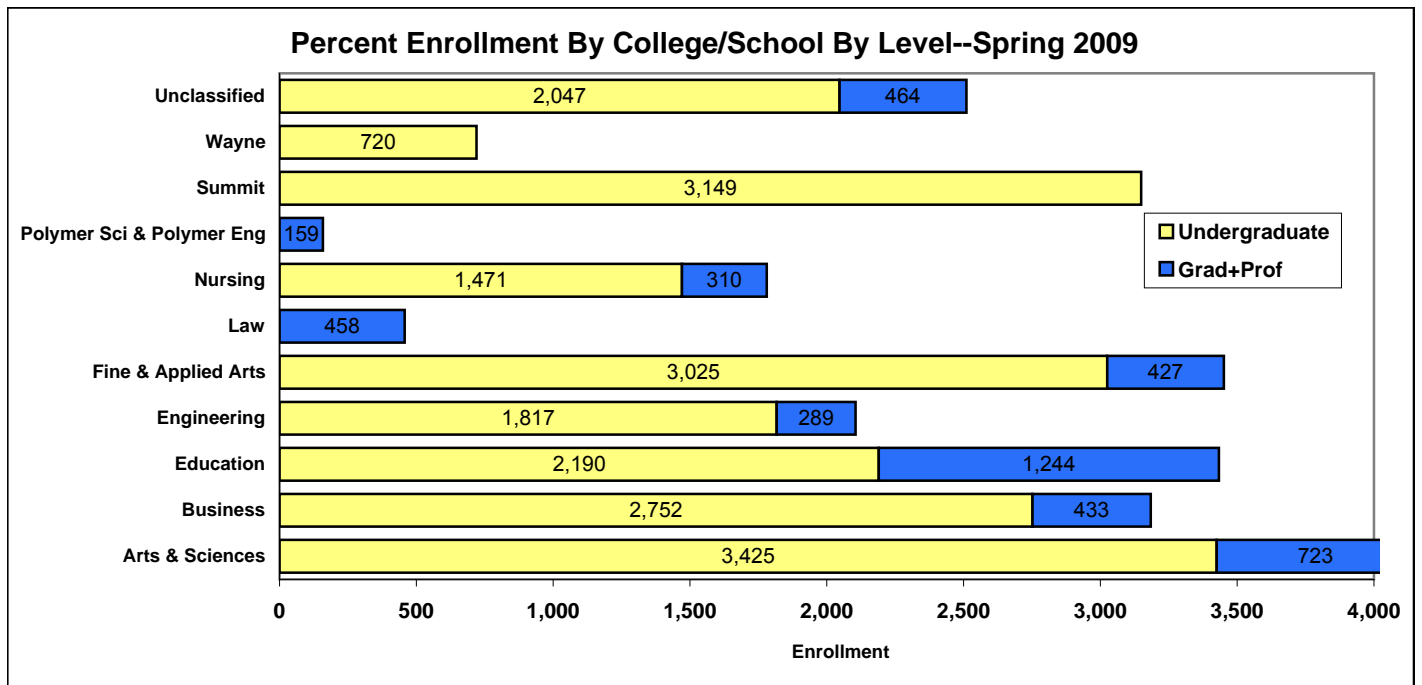

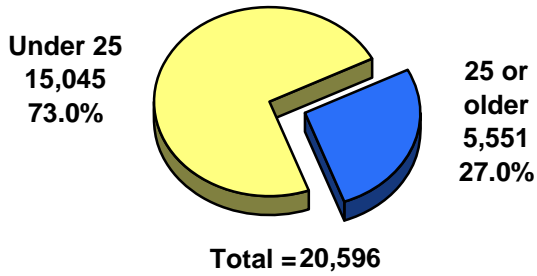

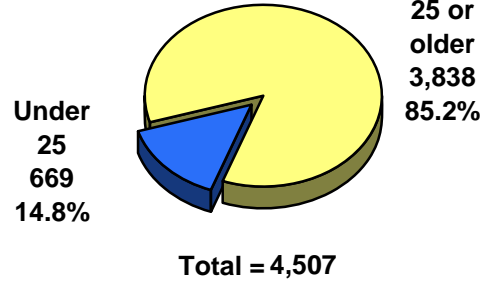


Age By Level--Spring 2009

Undergraduate



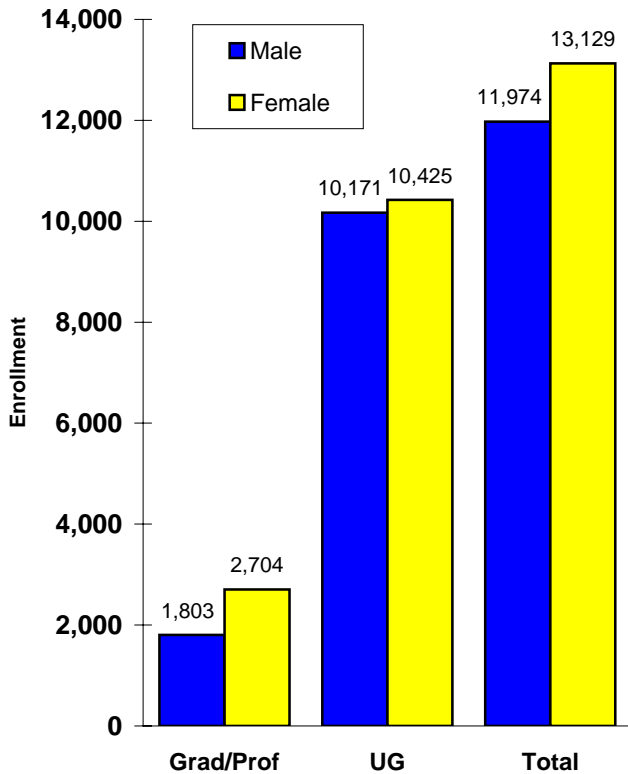
